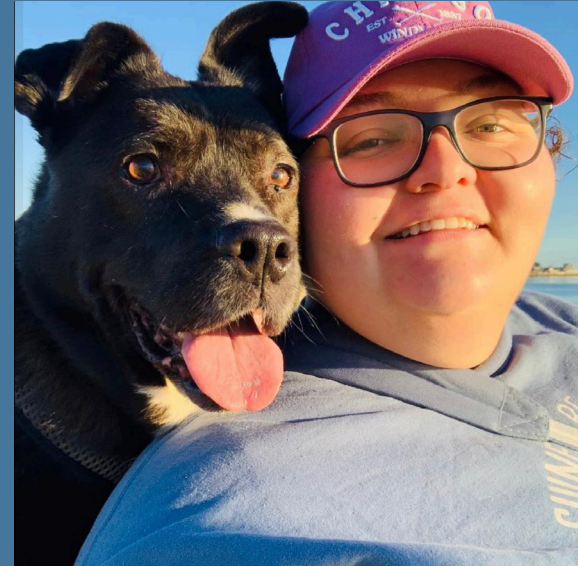


Meet our Behavior & Training Team!
